As you know, Spring Break is scheduled for April 6 - 10. - **Staff are on break 4/6-4/10 and may not be available to assist students with Edmentum. We will try to unlock tests within 24 hours.**
- **The Learning Period ends 4/21 with an expectation of 5 completed units. Therefore, students are expected to complete two units next week to stay on track.**
- **Students will officially return to distance learning on 4/13 after Spring Break, and daily check-ins will resume at this time.**
- **Distance learning will continue until 4/30 or until further notice.**
